

Hockey and Broomball Assumption of Risk Statement and Acknowledgment

In order to participate in any ice rink sport, you must realize injury is a very real possibility.

- 1) In the event you get hurt with any equipment or by another player, you may suffer from lacerations to the head, neck, arm, and/or other areas of the body.
- 2) Due to the speed and movement involved with any ice rink related activity, intentional or unintentional contact with another person or object (net, boards...) may cause bruises, fractures, concussions, injuries to the mouth/teeth or even more severe external or internal injuries including death.
- 3) Wearing required equipment and all recommended equipment does not imply nor guarantee an injury-free experience. The required and recommended equipment will greatly reduce the odds of injury.

Agreement to Waive Valuable Legal Rights

In consideration of receiving permission from Riverfront Park's Ice Palace to play ice hockey or any other ice rink related sport, in addition to the admission charge, which I have paid, I hereby expressly agree:

- 1) **To Assume All Risk and Responsibility for any Injuries I May Sustain**, any injuries I may cause to any other person and any damage I may cause to the Ice Palace or to my property or the property of others in connection with my activities at Riverfront Park (including without limitation, injuries or property damage caused by any equipment I may rent from Riverfront Park).
- 2) **To Release Riverfront Park, Parks and Recreation Department, City of Spokane and its Directors, Officers, Instructors, and Employees From all Claims and Liability** for an injuries I may sustain or any damage that may be caused to my property in the connection with my activities at Riverfront Park (including without limitation, injuries or property damage caused by any equipment I may rent from Riverfront Park) even if my injuries or damage to my property is caused, in whole or part by negligence or fault of the Ice Palace, its Directors, Officers, Instructors, or employees.

Private Ice Rentals and Broomball Events

In consideration for my safety and the safety of others and personal or rented equipment or property, the Riverfront Park ice rink will only be used for one ice activity at a time. Hockey or broomball can not be played simultaneously with recreational skating. During all ice activities excluding recreational skating at minimum a helmet will be wore despite the age and/or skill level of the participants. During broomball shoes or skates may be worn however all participants footwear must be the same.

I certify that I am at least 18 years of age and that I have the legal capacity to enter into this agreement. (Must be signed if under 18 years of age in conjunction with parental consent. Minimum age to play Drop-In-Hockey at Riverfront Park is 16 years old).
